HOW TO GET TO Gorge Metro Park.

Gorge Metro Park is located off of Front St., North of the Cuyahoga River, in Cuyahoga Falls.

From State Rt. 8: Exit at Broad Blvd. in Cuyahoga Falls. Turn left (west) on Broad Blvd. and go to Front St. Turn left onto Front St. and go south approx. one mi. The park entrance will be on the right just before crossing the Cuyahoga River bridge.
